Dear Parents,

We are all very pleased that the redevelopment of the Triangle site is nearing completion and I would hope it could coincide and herald a new chapter in all of Lincewood Primary School Parents having consideration for the safety of all our children. We continue to experience a minority of parents who completely disregard the parking restrictions outside the school including illegally parking on pavements and, therefore, having absolutely no concern for the safety of our pupils. With the new access available through the Triangle site from the High Road to the opening in Berry Lane, many of the children will be crossing Berry Lane directly opposite the school and it will be even more important that cars are not parked on the zig zags during restricted times as the children's view for crossing the road will be totally obscured. It is also illegal and dangerous to drop off children on the zig zags.

Unfortunately, I have no jurisdiction outside the School gates but I really hope that parents that continue to disregard the parking restrictions and thus the safety of our pupils will receive fines from the appropriate authorities.

If there are any parents who feel that these requests are unreasonable then I would be happy to discuss the matter in person with them. The majority of our parents are passionate about the parking issues outside the School and the parking laws being adhered to and we fully support them.
