<p>Maths and problem solving</p> 	<p>Practise counting 1 minute (60 seconds) in your head. Get an adult to check with a stopwatch, how close can you get?</p> <p>7 points Signed:</p>	<p>Practise reading the time with an adult. Start with o'clock and when you are confident move on to half past. <p>Art</p> 	<p>Draw some pictures of different bugs and insects. You could use paint, pens or crayons.</p> <p>7 points Signed:</p>	<p>Create a bug or insect using natural materials. You could use sticks, leaves, stones or anything else you can find in a garden or park. Take a photo of your masterpiece and stick it in your Busy Book!</p> <p>7 points Signed:</p>	<p>Create a picture of a bug or insect using collage. Cut up pieces of paper and stick them together to create your picture.</p> <p>10 points Signed:</p>

Draw or write your findings in your Busy Book.</p> <p>7 points Signed:</p>	<p>We are in our final half term of Year 1 and we are starting to look forward to being in Year 2.
