<p>Literacy and communication</p>	<p>Write a letter to your new secondary school form tutor (it does not matter if you are not sure where you are going) to introduce yourself. Make yourself sound interesting and wonderful – because you are.</p>	<p>Choose your favourite story and write a sequel. Think about all the aspects that will make a good story.</p>	<p>Design a poster about how wonderful Lincewood Primary School is.</p>
<p>Maths and problem solving</p>	<p>During an Olympic Games many national flags are on display.</p> <p>Pick a flag and investigate some of the following: What shapes can you see in it? Can you describe them and their angles? Does the flag have any lines of reflective symmetry, if so how many lines? Can you find any pairs of parallel lines? If so mark them on your flag. Are there any lines perpendicular to one another? Can you find a way to classify the shapes in your flag? Now try with another flag.</p>	<p>In this field we could say, because of the number of animals there, that each cow can see 4 sheep and 3 (other) cows. This could be worded as follows "Each cow can see one more sheep than cows." There are obviously 4 sheep and 4 cows in the field as you see it. But here are some questions about different fields in which you have to find out how many sheep and cows there are in each field.</p> <p>In field number 1, each cow can see twice as many sheep as cows; each sheep can see the same number of sheep as cows, so how many cows and sheep are there?</p> <p>In field number 2, each cow can see three times as many sheep as cows; each sheep can see the same number of sheep as cows, so how many cows and sheep are there?</p> <p>In field number 3, each cow can see twice as many sheep as cows; each sheep can see one more sheep than cows, so how many cows and sheep are there?</p> <p>In field number 4, each cow can see twice as many sheep as cows; each sheep can see two more sheep than cows, so how many cows and sheep are there?</p> <p>In field number 5, each cow can see three times as many sheep as cows; each sheep can see twice as many sheep as cows, so how many cows and sheep are there?</p>	
<p>Topic</p>	<p>Find a photograph of a famous person and create a portrait in the style of Andy Warhol.</p>	<p>Research Big Cats or Wild dogs and create a poster which shows the similarities and differences between the different species.</p>
