Uniform Reminder!



The school uniform consists of:

- *White shirt or blouse (long sleeves)*
- *White polo shirt (short sleeves)*
- *Bottle green jumper or cardigan*
- *School sweat shirt*
- *Grey or black trousers*
- *Green or grey pinafores or skirt*
- *Green and white check or stripe Summer dresses*
- *Sensible shoes - black or brown (no training shoes)*
- *Sandals - black, brown or white (appropriate styles, for example no high heels)*
- *Simple non-decorative hairbands or headbands only (green or black)*

Watches, jewellery and earrings, belts with metal buckles and another unnecessary encumbrances likely to prove dangerous to the wearer or to others, should not be worn. In the case of pierced ears, only small studs should be worn. All children must be able to remove earrings for PE and swimming lessons – even if they are newly pierced.

There are a greater number of children using watches with a text facility. If this cannot be disabled during school hours, please remind you child not to use this facility whilst at school.
